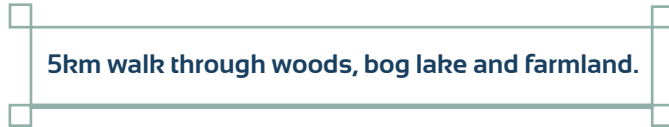

Walking Trails

PORTLICK CASTLE & FOREST WALK

A wonderful walk that explores the wooded glades and farmlands of Portlick and the Whinning peninsula of Lough Ree. Enjoy native trees and attractive and varied views of Lough Ree and an old ruin features near the south-west limit of the walking trail. The trail is 5km with shorter alternatives. GLASSON BOG WALK



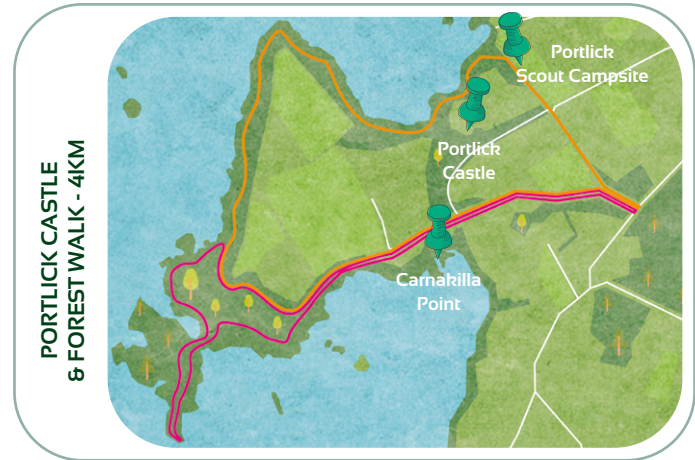
Walk to Glasson Village, cross the main road and follow lane directly in front of you.
